### Literacy:

- Reading: try the [oxfordowl.co.uk](http://oxfordowl.co.uk) - Choose one book to read for the week.


### Gaeilge:

### Maths:

- Warm-up (if needed use a 100 square)
  - Counting forward and backward from a random number  
Eg. 53,54,55,56 and 87,86,85,84
  - Counting in jumps 2s, 5s, 10s  
Eg. 5,10,15, 20 and 45,40,35,30
  - Pick a random number and add/subtract 2,3,4,5,10  
Eg. 75 and add 5, 29 and take 3
- Mental Maths – continuing at your own pace.

**Symmetry:** symmetry mean one side of a drawing is the same on the other side. Can you complete the following pictures?



**Challenge:** find a leaf while out for a walk. Cut it in half and see if you can complete the pattern on a page. Take a picture of what you have created.


**Science:**




Why not try a shape poem. Picture a shape you want and base the poem on that shape.




**Gaeilge:**

## Sun Safety Poster Design


### Amazing Fact
