Early Start Enrolment



Applications for places in the academic year 2020-21 will take place in the school hall.

Monday 3rd February – Fri. 7th February
From 9:10-10:00a.m.

To be eligible for **Early Start** a child **must be** 3 years of age on the 1st September 2020 and less than 4 years 7 months.

Forms for enrolling in Early Start are available at the office. You are welcome to collect the forms from Thursday 9th January. However completed forms **will not** be accepted or processed until the week beginning **Monday 3rd February until Friday 7th February. This will allow time to gather required documents.**

We are often oversubscribed for Early Start. We do our best to be fair to everyone. According to Department of Education and Skills guidelines priority must be given to the children who are most at risk of not reaching their potential in the education system.

No application will be accepted without the following.

1. Evidence of PPS no. – it can be found on your child's medical card.
2. Evidence of age: Birth certificate or passport.
3. Recent utility bill as proof of address.
