- **Maths:** Patterns

Patterns are made by repeating objects in a specific order.

Here is a 2-item pattern



What is the pattern?
What objects can you see?
What are the different colours you see?
What do you think will come next after the orange?
Can you make a pattern like this?

Here is a 3-item pattern

What is the pattern?
What order are the colours in?
How many different things can you see?
What will come after the white runner?
Can you make a pattern like this?

Wednesday 13th of January

- Literacy-
 - Practice writing your 'm' sound. If you have Playdoh at home, it might be fun to make an 'm' out of that too.
 - Play the jolly phonics song.

Here are things that start with M. Can you name any?



- Can you take a picture of something that starts with the letter 'm' around your house?
- Revise the sight words; you, it, of, in, was , said

Thursday 14th of January


Literacy
