4 Bug busting Days

Catherine, the Public Health nurse who

visited Scoil Nano Nagle during Healthy Lifestyle Week recommended a whole school approach to treating the problem of head lice. We request that all parents/guardians follow this 4 day plan. Day 1: Wednesday May 1st- wash, rinse, condition and fine comb hair while conditioner is still in. Leave for 3 days. Day 5: Sunday May 5th- Repeat as for Day 1. This will remove lice hatching from eggs before they can reproduce. Leave for 3 days. Day 9: Thursday May 9th. Repeat the same process. By day 10 the last eggs which are laid before the start of "Bugbusting" hatch. Day 13: Monday May 13th - Repeat process. As this is the 4th time to "Bugbust" all the lice are cleared. Only shiny empty shells are left on hair. Bugbust weekly and if any lice are found, start again.
