There is no need for pupils to bring in school bags or toys at this time. We are trying to limit what comes into school and what goes home.

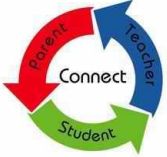

Thank you for respecting our request not to collect your child during the times of **1.20- 1.40 p.m. and 2.20- 2.40 p.m.**
