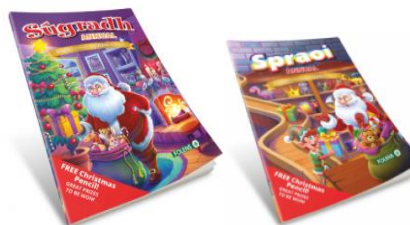


Bill payments

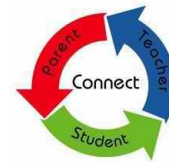
