### Pupil Insurance

If you wish to take out 24 hour insurance (J F Dunne Insurances) at a cost of **€5.50** for your child please email

The link was sent out by Peggy (secretary) where you can pay via Aladdin online. This insurance covers any expenses arising from an injury that a child might have whether in or out of school. It includes cover if your child damages teeth or has a serious accident involving loss of limbs. A copy of what is and is not covered can be emailed to you.

We understand that the main road outside the school gates can be very busy at drop off and collection times. Please be mindful of home owners in the area by not blocking driveways and gates.

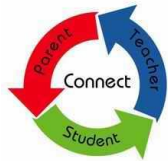
## “STOP for the Lollipop”
