### Label Clothes

**Uniforms:** Please ensure all jackets/jumpers/cardigans and coats and hats are labelled with your child's name to avoid any mix-ups during the year!

**Punctuality:** 'Start as you mean to go on'- bringing your child to school on time is so important-ensuring your child is lined up with the class outside means they are ready to start on time with their classmates.

**Attendance:** Please inform the school if you know in advance, if your child won't be in, by text or voice message (**please speak slowly and clearly when leaving a voice message**). Just a reminder that any calls/messages concerning attendance should be directed to the mobile number at the top of the newsletter ☎: **087 1755308** and **not** the school number. If there is no answer please leave a message. We thank you for your co-operation.

**Early Collections:** Please try to organise appointments after school hours if possible. It is important that your child remains at school until the official school day ends as he/she is missing out on valuable curriculum time and this impinges on their learning and

overall success. We would ask for your co-operation in this matter.
