

to there is still time. If you wish to take-out 24hour Insurance (J F Dunne Insurances) at a cost of €5.61 for your child please email nanonagleparentsassociation@gmail.com giving your child's name and class teacher.

This insurance covers any expenses arising from an injury that a child might have whether in or out of school. It includes cover if your child damages teeth or has a serious accident involving loss of limbs. Label Clothes

<u>Uniforms:</u> Please ensure all jackets/jumpers/cardigans and coats and hats are labelled with your child's name to avoid any mix-ups during the year!

<u>Punctuality</u>: 'Start as you mean to go on'bringing your child to school on time is so important-ensuring your child is lined up with the class outside means they are ready to start on time with their classmates.

Attendance: Please inform the school if you know in advance, that your child won't be in, by text or voice message (please speak slowly and clearly when leaving a voice message). Just a reminder that any calls/messages concerning attendance should be directed to the mobile number at the top of the newsletter

If there is no answer please leave a message. We thank you for your co-operation.

Early Collections: Please try to organise appointments after school hours if possible. It is important that your child remains at school until the official school day ends as he/she is missing out on valuable curriculum time and this impinges on their learning and overall success. We would ask for your cooperation in this matter.

Updated Contact Details

Please inform the school of any change of telephone number/address/email by filling out the <u>vellow</u> form available from Peggy at reception. This can be done at any stage during the year. It is very important that the school has correct contact details in case we need to contact you.

Illnesses

It is very important that the school be told if your child develops any form of serious illness during the year. This should be done as soon as possible in order to ensure that we can take the necessary steps to safeguard all pupils and staff. If your child is ill, he/she should be kept at home and follow medical advice.

Dogs

Dogs are strictly forbidden on the school grounds for hazardous and safety reasons. We are informing you that dogs are not allowed inside the main school gate, on the school grounds at any time under any circumstances.

Scooters & Electric Bikes





While we endorse and commend walking, cycling and scooting to school daily, please be advised that electric scooters and electric bikes (e-scooters) are strictly forbidden on the school grounds at any time, under any circumstances for safety reasons. If adults and children cycle/travel to school by this means please dismount from your bicycle/scooter inside the main gate. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding on this matter.

Disabled Parking Space and Zig-Zag lines

There is a designated disabled parking space outside the school gates. If you do not have a disabled cert, please park in any of the other spaces. Your cooperation on this matter is greatly appreciated by those who need to use the disabled parking space on a regular basis.



Also, parking on the yellow Zig-Zag lines must be avoided at all times.
