School Lunch



Pupils new to Early Start, Junior Infants and New pupils to the school in other classes should receive Student ID's and access codes with instructions on how to register with www.glanmorefoods.ie soon.

Once this has happened, please register with Glanmore. Then, you will then be able to change your child's lunch choice as often as you like.

For Senior Infants, 1st & 2nd classes if you have not already registered over the past few years your child's class teacher should have a copy of the student ID and access code with instructions on how to register with Glanmore.

Pupil Insurance

If you wish to take out 24 hour insurance (J F Dunne Insurances) at a cost of **€5.50** for your child please email nanonagleparentsassociation@gmail.com giving your child's name and class teacher. The link was sent out by Peggy (secretary) where you can pay via Aladdin online. This insurance covers any expenses arising from an injury that a child might have whether in or out of school. It includes cover if your child damages teeth or has a serious accident involving loss of limbs. A copy of what is and is not covered can be emailed to you.

Back to School Reminders



Punctuality: 'Start as you mean to go on'-bringing your child to school on time is so important-

ensuring your child is lined up with the class outside means they are ready to start on time with their classmates.

Attendance: Please inform the school if you know in advance, that your child won't be in, by text or voice message (**please speak slowly and clearly when leaving a voice message**). If there is no answer please leave a message. We thank you for your co-operation.

Early Collections: Please try to organise appointments after school hours if possible. It is important that your child remains at school until the official school day ends as he/she is missing out on valuable curriculum time and this impinges on their learning and overall success. We would ask for your co-operation in this matter.

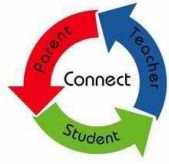
