Pupil Insurance

As we are no longer taking cash, 24 hour pupil insurance cover can be paid online. If you wish to take out 24 hour insurance at a cost of **€5.50** for your child please email nanonagleparentsassociation1@gmail.com giving your child's name and class teacher. You will receive a link where you can pay online. This insurance covers any expenses arising from an injury that a child might have whether in or out of school. It includes cover if your child damages teeth or has a serious accident involving loss of limbs. A copy of what is and is not covered will be emailed to you.

The school will close at **12 o'clock on Friday 8th October** for staff training and will re-open on **Monday 11th October at 9.00 am.**

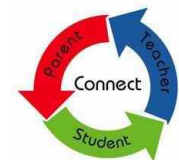
As it is a half day there will be a light snack provided for all children.
