

Nano Nagle- a little bit of history

Nano Nagle was born in Cork in 1718. She taught children during the day and visited and nursed the sick at night. She became known as "The Lady with the Lantern" She founded the Presentation sisters and set up schools across Ireland and abroad. There is a framed photograph of Nano Nagle in the reception area. Our school, Scoil Nano Nagle, is named after this great educator and caring person. Nano Nagle's life and work is celebrated every

year on Presentation Day - November 21st.
