
We would like to remind parents/guardians of the importance of wearing masks when vou drop vour child off to school in the morning and again at collection times.

All Early Start and Junior Infant pupils have received a letter from our food suppliers Glanmore Foods www.glanmorefoods.ie

Your child's name is on this letter with a student ID and access code.

- 1. Please register by following the instructions on the letter as soon as possible.
- 2. You will then get a confirmation letter from Glanmore with a password.
- 3. You can then log on any time to change your child's lunch.
- 4. The username is your email address and use the password you were given by Glanmore when you registered.
- 5. If you forget your password log on to www.glanmorefoods.ie and type in your email address where it says username and click forgotten password. You will then be issued with a new password.

Pupil Insurance
